1981, Quiberon, France. One year before her death, Romy Schneider, the most famous female star in Europe of her time, has come to this small seaside village to recuperate in a spa hotel. She is visited by her close friend Hilde, who has come to offer the support she needs to fight her demons. But this is more than just the reunion of two old friends.

Despite her previous negative encounters with the German Press, Schneider has granted "Stern" magazine reporter Michael Jürgs and photographer Robert Lebeck an interview and photoshoot that form the basis of this film. What unfolds over these three days is a cat-and-mouse game between the fragile actress and the ambitious writer, in which Schneider bares her soul, almost to breaking point. The interaction between the quartet ranges from tenderness to brutal manipulation, an emotional roller coaster ride which nevertheless allows Romy to rediscover her zest for life and the inner strength to carry on.

Cinematographer Thomas Kiennast's striking camerawork captures not only the feel of Lebeck's photographs, but also Schneider's vulnerability. What emerges is a multifaceted portrait of a compelling actress and woman who unsparingly gives her all.
