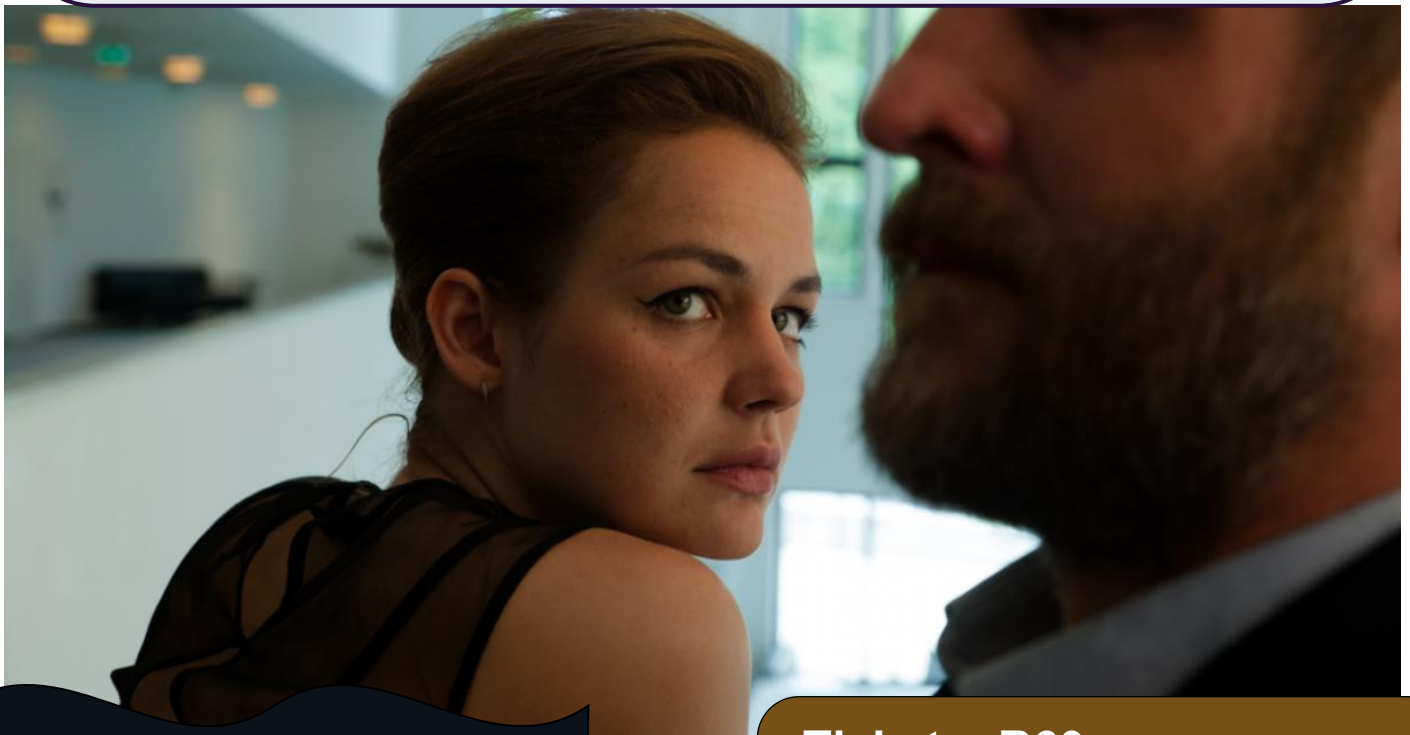

Liv and Malte, two young teachers, are spending their summer holidays on a Mediterranean island. This soon turns into a nightmare when three young men raid the house they are staying in and rape Liv. The couple returns home to Germany, and slowly starts adapting to their normal life again. Two years later, Malte and Liv are not only still together, but demonstrating an amazing strength in dealing with the trauma, determined that it will not tear them apart. Until one day Malte runs into one of the assailants and is filled with an insatiable hunger for revenge. The delicate balance of the couple's relationship is faced with danger once again. This extraordinary but all the more hopeful love story was nominated for the German Film Prize for best performance by an actress in a leading role in 2019.
